The Witness of Christ (Acts 7)

- 1. The accusations against Stephen were that he was changing the teachings of the OT Scriptures. That He was starting a new religion with Jesus. Stephen showed that Jesus fulfilled the Old Testament in his death and Resurrection. Read Stephen's conclusion (Acts 7:51-53) and discuss the Israelites response to the prophets and their message. How is this similar to the Jews response to Jesus?
- 2. Read The following passages and discuss Jesus own words describing His relationship to the Old Testament law and prophets.
 - Matthew 5:17-18
 - Luke 24:27
- 3. Read Hebrews 10:1-4 and describe the problem that the Old Testament had in atoning for sin.
- 4. Read Hebrews 10:12-14 and describe how Jesus Christ fulfilled the Law by being the ultimate sacrifice. How does He accomplish this "once and for all?"
